Re: **Canadians for Safe Access ("CFSA")
Publication of Defamatory Libel
Regarding Prairie Plant Systems Inc. ("Prairie Plant Systems")**

We are solicitors for Prairie Plant Systems in regard to the above-noted matter. Our client has brought to our attention you and your organization's sustained and malicious campaign to damage our client's business reputation and the reputation of its products. The latest publication is your "Open Letter of Concern for the Health and Safety of Canada's Medicinal Cannabis Community" dated January 1, 2005 and published on your website, www.safeaccess.ca, and sent to Members of Parliament and Senators.

While anyone is entitled to express their views on a particular topic you are however, not entitled to publish false and misleading information which harms Prairie Plant Systems' reputation. Statements made by you about our client and its product that are clearly false and/or misleading are as follows:

1. Your suggestion that the content and potency of medical marijuana produced by Prairie Plant Systems is other than as reported on the package label;
2. Your claim that Prairie Plant Systems' product has high levels of heavy metals;
3. Your claim that Prairie Plant Systems' product has high levels of heavy metals because it is produced near Flin Flon, Manitoba;
4. Your claim that independent tests show Prairie Plant Systems' product to have "alarmingly high level of biological impurities"; and

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5. Your claim that Prairie Plant Systems' product is unsafe because of the use of gamma irradiation.

Our client's response is particularized in its Response dated January 27, 2005.

Our client is a leader in the field of plant-made pharmaceuticals. The federal government contract to produce clinical grade marijuana is only one of its many contracts, and your defaming and false statements impact all parts of its business. Our client demands that you immediately remove your defamatory statements about it from your website and that you cease publishing such statements in the future. Should you neglect to cease and desist (to this request) our client intends to pursue all legal remedies available to it.

Thank you for the update. Jacques will be back at the office next week. Please note that the Cof A posted on CSA website is unreadable once printed. In any case, just to let you know, H34 material for which there is the highest microbial count reported was not irradiated being a bulk harvest. It has not been considered for packaging into finished product.

The revised Product Information Sheets have been processed today for posting on HC website. This should be done within the next day or so. In addition all the laboratory results from metal and microbial analysis for Lot 3 currently distributed will be posted on HC website (testing ongoing during Holiday season - I need to follow up with Larry).

Finally HC is working on a response to address CSA concerns regarding aflatoxins and by-products generated from irradiation gamma. had contacted Richard on December 1 in relation to these issues / concerns.

PS: The AT! office is the one who makes the decision. DAS can only strongly recommend not to disclose.
